



Orthodontic Permit Class Schedule

The Orthodontic Permit course consists of lecture, three days of classroom instruction and clinical practice in your dental employment office or dental facility that will allow the performance of advanced orthodontic procedures on patients. The lecture is presented through a home study program that you study in the privacy of your home at your time schedule. The three days of class will consist of practicing advanced orthodontic procedures on typodonts.

Upon completion of the three days of classroom instruction, students will be required to perform specific orthodontic procedures in their dental employment office or dental facility that will allow you to perform clinically.

Classroom hours are from 8:00am - 5:00 pm
