



Pit and Fissure Sealant Class Schedule

The 16-hour pit and fissure sealant course consist of classroom instruction, completion of a home study program and clinical practice in your dental employment office or dental facility that will allow the performance of sealants on patients. The theory is presented through a home study program. The one day of class will consist of practicing sealants on teeth on a typodont, two clinical outpatients. Two clinical patients will be required to be performed in dental employment office or dental facility after the one day of instruction.

Note: Certificates will be issued 7-10 days after the course.
